Dallas Angel Investor Robert Breville Awarded Top Honors for Entrepreneurship

Dallas, Texas, USA, July 14, 2023 - /PressReleasePoint/ - In an affluent, gated waterfront neighborhood in the suburbs of Dallas is an award-winning innovator tinkering on his latest projects in a massive Texas-sized garage outfitted with computers, plasma cutters, presses, and custom tooling surrounded by classic cars and all-terrain vehicles. Robert Breville is a Fortune 500 executive that has spent the last several years as an angel investor, venture capitalist, fund manager, startup advisor, and innovator. This year, he is once again being recognized as one of the world's best innovators and entrepreneurs. Previously, Robert was named a *Top 10 Angel Investor* in Dallas and Silicon Valley, a *Top 100 Investor that Supports Veteran Owned Businesses*, and his accelerator, Tech Wildcatters, was nationally ranked in the *Top 10* by Forbes and by MIT.

Robert will be featured in the *Top 100 Innovators and Entrepreneurs* magazine which will be published in Q3 of this year.

Kenneth Tung, formerly of Tech Wildcatters, said it was "no surprise that Robert was selected". As a mentor, Robert's calendar was always booked weeks or months in advance. He was in high demand with the startup founders at Tech Wildcatters and Capital Factory. "Robert would give feedback to startups on how to optimize their strategy and pitch," said Kenneth.

"His guidance and advice were invaluable in both business and technical expertise," said Chandler Young, Founder of iJustOrder. "When we had technical sourcing issues, Robert solved them immediately. When we had contract issues, he helped solve those immediately. He even gave branding advice which we still use today." Robert served on the board of directors with Chandler.

"Robert was a trusted advisor and board member," said Justin White, Founder of Selery Fulfillment. "He was instrumental in helping us raise millions of dollars to grow and scale Selery." Robert served as Chairman of the Board of Directors of Selery.

Robert is an engineer, software developer, economist, and business leader by education and trade. He is regarded as an industry expert in venture capital, aerospace, defense, communications, agritech, fintech, remote sensing, cyber security, image processing, and electronic warfare.

"We followed Robert as he was interviewed for the magazine feature and offered guest spots on VC podcasts," said startup community organizer Sarah Liu. "Robert bounced back and forth from the National Science Foundation lab, UT-Dallas, and his garage. He was always designing, building, or customizing something from venture-backed to personal pet projects. With a background in engineering, physics, materials science, and software, it is not unusual to find him modeling a product in CAD, prototyping with a 3D printer or QRC facility, welding, wiring, and writing software to control it all."

"Robert is pure genius," said Chandler. "When he speaks, you better listen because it's the difference between success and failure."

Kenneth had similar advice. "Listen and see what you can gather from his experience and knowledge."

Robert has received awards in Innovation from NASA and Engineering Excellence from Raytheon and Leonardo. Robert serves on the Board of Directors of the BCT and he is a member of the Order of the Engineer, Armed Forces Communications and Electronics Association, and Mensa.
